Company legal brain

Documents, decisions, timeline, and audit stay attached to the matter, not scattered in Drive.

5 · SPECIALIST BENCH

Lawyer routing

Serious matters route to licensed specialists. Two-sided network compounds as matters flow through.

6 · AUDIT & CLOSE

Provenance ledger

Every clause, change, model call, and signature carries a tamper-evident record.
